

# Graduate Student Scholarships and Research Awards

## Department of Anthropology

### **Norton Allen Memorial Scholarship (all subfields)**

Source: A gift from Ethel Crane Allen and friends  
Eligibility: Arizona residents, anthropology graduate students, with a preference given to Native Americans  
Purpose: To provide funding for the education of outstanding graduate students  
Funding: One or more awards, amounts vary

### **Comins Fellowship Fund (sociocultural anthropology)**

Source: Established by Eben F. Comins  
Eligibility: Anthropology graduate students engaged in studies that may contribute to the cultural understanding of the Native American Indian  
Purpose: To provide funding for the education of outstanding anthropology graduate students  
Funding: One or more awards, amounts vary, not to exceed \$1200

### **William Shirley Fulton Scholarship (archaeology)**

Source: A bequest by the late William Shirley Fulton, pioneer Arizona archaeologist, and founder of the Amerind Foundation of Dragoon, Arizona  
Eligibility: Outstanding archaeology graduate students  
Purpose: To provide funding for the education of outstanding archaeology graduate students  
Funding: One or more awards, amounts vary

### **Stanley R. Grant Scholarship Fund (all subfields)**

Source: Established by Joan B. Grant in honor of her husband  
Eligibility: Anthropology graduate students with good academic standing  
Purpose: To provide funding for anthropology graduate students studying the native peoples of the Americas  
Funding: One or more awards, amounts vary

### **Emil W. Haury Education Fund for Archaeology (archaeology)**

Source: Contributions for the advancement of archaeological learning, established by friends and colleagues of Emil W. Haury, Head of the Department of Anthropology and Director of the Arizona State Museum  
Eligibility: Archaeology graduate students of demonstrated scholastic ability  
Purpose: To provide outstanding archaeology graduate students with funds for the following: 1) general education needs; 2) a special research project; 3) exceptionally meritorious work; and 4) a dissertation research project  
Funding: One or more awards, amounts vary

### **Mary Alice Sherry Helm Scholarship (all subfields)**

Source: A gift from her mother, Ilene Mills Sherry, and family and friends of Mary Alice Sherry Helm who received a MA degree from the University of Arizona

Eligibility: Anthropology graduate students with preference given to those planning to enter the field of Museum Administration

Purpose: To provide funding for the education of outstanding graduate students

Funding: One or more awards, amounts vary

### **Carol Kramer Memorial Scholarship (archaeology)**

Source: Contributions from friends and colleagues of Carol Kramer, Near Eastern archaeologist, leader in the field of ethnoarchaeology, and faculty member in the Department of Anthropology

Eligibility: Archaeology graduate students engaged in research in Near Eastern archaeology or ethnoarchaeology

Purpose: To provide funding for archaeology graduate students

Funding: One or more awards, amounts vary

### **William A. Longacre Graduate Scholarship in Anthropology (archaeology)**

Source: Generous contributions from friends and alumni who attended the William A. Longacre Roast and Scholarship Fundraiser; and other contributions from friends, colleagues, students, and alumni

Eligibility: Archaeology graduate students

Purpose: For graduate students seeking a degree in the Department of Anthropology; specifically within the subfield of Archaeology

Funding: One or more awards, amounts vary

### **Louie and Frances-Fera Schiffer Scholarship (archaeology)**

Source: Generous friends who appreciate the importance of fostering the professional development of archaeology graduate students.

Eligibility: Archaeology graduate students who will present a paper or poster at a national meeting

Purpose: To provide funding for archaeology graduate students

Funding: One or more awards, amounts vary

Source: Department of Anthropology, in memory of Edward H. Spicer, distinguished cultural anthropologist and faculty member of the Department of Anthropology

Eligibility: Cultural anthropology graduate students

Purpose: To help fund field research in southwestern United States and northern Mexico

Funding: One or more awards, amounts vary

### **William and Nancy Sullivan Scholarship (all subfields)**

Source: A bequest from Nancy Epler Sullivan

Eligibility: Outstanding graduate students majoring in Anthropology with demonstrated scholastic ability and who are Arizona residents.

Purpose: To provide funding for anthropology graduate students

Funding: One or more awards, amounts vary

Source: Department of Anthropology Traditions, Transitions, and Treasures Auction and donations

Eligibility: Anthropology graduate students
